

TE HĀ ART AWARD 2018

Te Hā Trust and Tairāwhiti Museum invite you to submit your interpretation of this year's theme:

Tuia te muka tangata
Weaving together the threads of humanity

The Tairāwhiti region is rich in histories of collective and deep personal narrative. This year's Te Hā Art Awards are calling for artistic expressions exploring the many rich histories that are woven into the fabric and landscape of Te Tairāwhiti.

The Te Hā arts award exhibition will be selected from submissions and the awards presented at the exhibition opening on **Friday 5 October at Tairāwhiti Museum**

Conditions of entry

Entry is free and all work must be received at Tairāwhiti Museum with an entry form (available from Tairāwhiti Museum reception or www.tairawhitimuseum.org.nz) securely attached by **Thursday 27th September**.

Late entries will not be accepted

- Up to two works (in any medium) completed over the past 12 months may be submitted by individual artists.
 - The work must not infringe upon NZ copyright laws, and must be the sole work of the artist.
 - All works must be for sale, and must include 30% gallery commission plus 15% GST
 - By entering work in the awards the artist gives permission for Tairāwhiti Museum and Te Hā Trust to reproduce the works (credited) for promotional purposes associated with the awards and exhibition.

Size and presentation

Work must not exceed 1.5metres including frame

Freight and insurance

Freighting and insurance of works to and from the gallery and while on display in the gallery is the sole responsibility of the entrant. All reasonable care will be taken in the handling of all entries, but no liability for loss or damage will be accepted by Tairāwhiti Museum.

Selected Works:

The Te Hā Art Award exhibition will be selected from the entries received.

Entries which are not selected for the exhibition must be uplifted – **as soon as possible**

Museum staff and Te Hā Trust staff and their families may enter for the exhibition but will not be eligible for the awards.

Judging:

The winner of each section will be determined by a judge or judges.

Judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered in to.
